“Evidence Based Cardio Pulmonary Physiotherapy”

Workshop was conducted on 17th and 18th of February 2015 on the theme Evidence Based Cardio Pulmonary Physiotherapy. Dr. P. Chandramohan, Vice Chancellor of YU, inaugurated the workshop. Prof (Dr) C.V Raghuvier, the Registrar YU, Prof. Abdul Rahman former Vice Chancellor, Dr. Asha P Shetty Dean and Principal YNC, and other HODs of different department of YNC was present for the inaugural function. Welcome address was given by the organizing chairman of the workshop Prof. S Padmakumar Dean and Principal YPC, presidential address was given by the Vice Chancellor Dr. P Chandramohan and vote of thanks by the organizing secretary Nigath Fathima Asst. Prof. YPC. The resource person for the workshop was Prof. Narsiman Swaminathan faculty of health sciences, INTI international university Malaysia. First day session was regarding the basic physiology, and clinical reasoning, assessment procedures like history taking, subjective examination in cardiorespiratory physiotherapy. Second session was regarding the investigation procedures like x ray, PFT, ABG, exercise testing and basic pathophysiology of major cardiac and respiratory disorders. Students also had an ICU visit with different practical demonstration.

Around 30 students participated in the workshop and other staff members of YPC. The workshop lasted for two days and at the end of the workshop students were able to understand the basics of physiotherapy evaluation and identify the impairments, plan and implement physiotherapy in subjects with cardio pulmonary disorders. The CME was partly financed by Yenepoya University.
