Department of Community Dentistry has a 29 inch television for the screening of educative films and video shows.

Additionally, the YDC also has a state-of-the-art mobile dental van. The Dental Materials Department has a unique Museum of Dental Materials. The Community Dentistry Department has mobile dental clinics that are used to proactively to interact with the community.

All the treatment is rendered free or at very minimal rates. The departments conduct frequent dental camps in the rural areas surrounding Mangalore. The Dental College holds frequent Continuing Dental Education programs and guest lectures. YDC has a computer graphics department with all the latest equipment, which caters to the DTP and other needs of the Institutions.

The Central Library & Digital Information Centre, the Indoor and outdoor auditoria, the Canteen and the Examination hall are shared facilities.






