

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (herein after referred to as "Agreement") is made and executed on this 17th day of November 2014 by and between:

Yenepoya Medical College (Constituent College of Yenepoya University) University Road, Derlakatte, Mangalore – 575 018 hereinafter called as Party 1.

AND

Shree Devi College of Pharmacy, Airport Road, Kenjar Village, Malayons Panchayath, Mangalore Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) -574 142 hereinafter called as Party 2.

University Road, Deralakatte Mangalore 575 018, Karnataka. It is agreed that Party 1, Yenepoya Medical College, Mangalore constituent College of Yenepoya University, Mangalore shall provide Practical Training to the Pharm.D students of Shree Devi College of Pharmacy, Mangalore on the terms and conditions detailed as under:

- 1. The Pharm.D Students shall be attending the Yenepoya Medical College Hospital once in a week in the forenoon or afternoon as decided by the Party 1 and Party 2 mutually in the interest of the students of both the Institutions.
- 2. The Party 1 shall provide necessary furniture, audio visual and other related materials at Yenepoya Medical College Hospital for the training of the Pharm.D students of Party 2.
- 3. The Pharm D students of Party 2 shall abide by the code of conduct, discipline followed by the Institution of Party 1. The Pharm.D students shall be displaying their identity cards and wear a proper apron during their training in the Yenepoya Medical College Hospital.
- 4. Party 2 shall be responsible for the transportation of the Pharm.D students during their training at the Yenepoya Medical College Hospital.
- 5. Party 1 and Party 2 shall explore the areas of Joint Research and constitute a Committee to look into the collaborative research. Party 1 shall be responsible to constitute a committee after receiving 03 names for the Committee from Shree Devi College of Pharmacy.
- 6. The Party 2 shall be reimbursing a training fee of Rs. 10,000/- per student to the Party 1 in the shape of Bank Draft Payable to Yenepoya Medical College, Mangalore.
- 7. The Memorandum of Understanding between Party 1 and Party 2 can be revoked on the request of any Party with a notice period of 02 months.

8. The Training shall commence w.e.f. 1st December 2014.
