



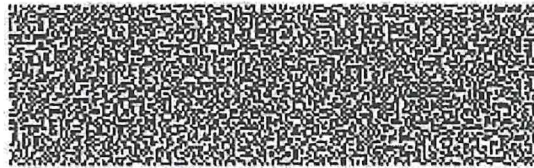
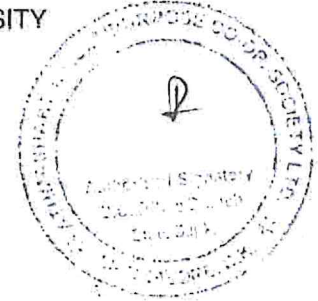

5. Work collectively towards integrating and upgrading digital health technology solutions currently available with both parties
6. Capacity building of students, faculties, researchers and field staff in efficient and quality data capture.
7. To promote the development of training modules and course maternal by involving faculty/ researchers from two institutions.
8. Explore the possibility of developing and implementing software solutions for research and community service.
9. In case that research result impacting upon matters of intellectual property rights are expected to arise in the course of collaborative projects within the scope of this protocol, the parties shall enter into an additional protocol governing the conditions regarding the treatment of intellectual property rights specially arising, prior to the start of the collaborative project in question.
10. This protocol shall be in effect for three years following the date of signature. This protocol may be complemented or amended by the written and common consent of authorized representatives of both institutions and additional protocols to this protocol. The addenda or amendments will not be valid unless it is written and signed. The protocol may be extended for another two years by written and signed consent of the parties.

Brief summary of the camp:

The camp was declared open by Dr. Pracheth R and the Anaganwadi Worker of Kudroli Anganwadi at 10.00 am. A team comprising of three specialists from Community Medicine,

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Paediatrics and OBG, nursing aid and a laboratory technician conducted the camp. The doctors examined and treated the beneficiaries. Laboratory investigations like random blood sugar and rapid test for COVID-19 were conducted. Most of the beneficiaries were children followed by adults who came for hypertension and diabetes mellitus screening. Anthropometric measurements like height and weight were carried out for all the children beneficiaries by the Anganwadi Worker and the helper. Drugs like analgesics, antipyretics, H2 blockers, and anti-hypertensives were dispensed. Beneficiaries who needed referral, were given a referral slip and advised to take further treatment in the higher center. The camp closed at 12.30 pm.

This was followed by observation of World Daughters Day by the Anganwadi Worker. Two girls who were former beneficiaries of the Anganwadi inaugurated the programme by lighting the lamp. 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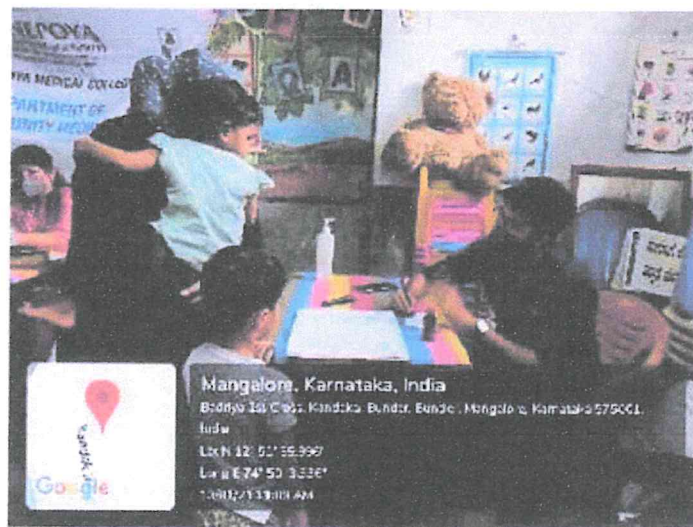

The residents were screened for hypertension and diabetes by doing BP measurement and Blood sugar measurement using Glucometer.
