



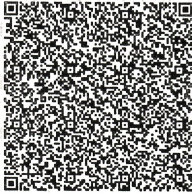

**BETWEEN**

**Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) Deralakatte**, a premier University in India established on February 2008 under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 represented by its Registrar having their registered office at Deralakatte, Mangalore 575018, Karnataka, India, hereinafter referred to as "**YENEPOYA, DERALAKATTE**", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns as party of the **FIRST PART**.

**AND**

**JeevaRaksha Trust**, a non-profit organization registered under Karnataka Societies Registration Act (Reg. no. BNG(U)262/2019-20/BK IV ) is a special purpose vehicle created by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS) and Swami Vivekananda Youth Movement (SVYM), with its Administrative office at 570 12<sup>th</sup> A cross road, 8<sup>th</sup> Main road, J P Nagar, 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase, Bengaluru, Karnataka, India - 560078, and with a mission to facilitate and develop processes that improve the quality of life of people, represented by its Chief Executive Officer, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns as party of the **SECOND PART**.

**Scope of the Memorandum of Understanding**

YENEPOYA and JEEVARAKSHA TRUST together are keen on developing, research projects, disaster management protocols and skilled health care professionals and citizen volunteers for 'saving lives' by 'efficient clinical management' during 'all medical emergencies.' Thus, this Memorandum of Understanding.

*The Memorandum of Understanding has been drawn on the following terms and conditions*

**Vision:** *Saving lives, assuring quality emergency health care*

**Goal:** *To jointly train and certify candidates as JeevaRaksha Providers by offering skills training to doctors, nurses, other healthcare professionals and citizen volunteers in curriculum of current international standards as well as create a disaster management protocol for the region and collaborating in research.*

**In order to facilitate the above, YENEPOYA, DERALAKATTE and JEEVARAKSHA TRUST intend to collaborate as follows:**

**1. The JeevaRaksha Trust (JRT) will:**

- A. Be responsible for training instructors, certifying training centers and curriculum development as follows:
- i. Provide the required JeevaRaksha instructors to conduct each JeevaRaksha Instructor programs for all emergency care training modules
  - ii. Provide curriculum implementation resources.
  - iii. Provide ongoing curriculum updates for all the modules and access to JeevaRaksha Instructor Network and the Learning Management System
  - iv. Provide access for providers and instructors to the JeevaRaksha App
  - v. Will retain the intellectual property rights to the curriculum and its products which will feature the JeevaRaksha Logo.
- B. Facilitate student and faculty exchange programmes through JeevaRaksha Expert Network with foreign universities including University of Utah, USA.
- C. Co-ordinate research projects in developing state of the art tools in emergency care education and product development
- D. The following criteria would be adopted for certification of instructors and institutions (training centers).

**Instructors will be certified by the JRT after the individual candidate has met these criteria:**

- i. Successfully completed the basic provider curriculum with 90% marks (maximum 3 attempts) as against the 70% pass mark required for the providers.
- ii. Successfully completed ToT (Training of Trainers) workshop.
- iii. Successfully completed the required number of JR supervised provider workshops.
- iv. Provider and Instructor certification is valid for five years and the instructors should teach in a minimum of two courses per year (ECLS – 8 course days, ENLS – 8 course days and BCLS – 4 course days) to keep their Instructor status, active.

**2. The YENEPOYA (deemed to be university), DERALAKATTE will:**

- A. Establish infrastructure and human resources:
- i. Appoint a JeevaRaksha Programme Director (has to be an ECLS Instructor) for the skills centre, who will liaison with JeevaRaksha training centers and instructors to collaborate and conduct workshops.
  - ii. Nominate an administrator to handle the Learning Management System (LMS). This administrator will be supervised by the concerned JeevaRaksha Course Director and will maintain all data pertaining to the JeevaRaksha workshops, including demographics of participants, instructors and workshop specific data.

- iii. Assist innominating eligible candidates for Instructors program.
  - iv. Collaborate in JeevaRaksha Research Projects.
  - v. Make available the necessary physical and human resources required to conduct the course.
  - vi. Regular monitoring and evaluation to ensure the quality assurance of the JeevaRaksha Courses
- B. Provide human resources and local facilities to conduct research projects and support national and international presentations on the same.
- C. Depute faculty and representatives to the disaster protocol development core group (including government authorities and other local healthcare organisations) and conduct disaster response training for healthcare professionals, emergency service providers and citizen volunteers
- D. For all candidates trained in JeevaRaksha courses, 30% of the course fee will be transferred to RGUHS-JeevaRaksha Trust account for administration, online CPD support and certification charges. The maximum fees to be collected per candidate for each course is as below:

<u>Course</u>	<u>Duration</u>	<u>Maximum Fees</u>
▪ ECLS (Emergency Care and Life Support)	4 Days	10,000
▪ ENLS (Emergency Nursing and Life Support)	3 Days	7,500
▪ BCLS (Basic Care and Life Support)	1Day	5,000

- E. Facilitate travel and accommodation arrangements including TA, DA to the training site for JRT faculty, as follows:
- i. Reimburse round-trip road, rail or air (economy class) fares for JRT instructors in a timely manner.
  - ii. Provide local transportation to and from the transport hub, training site/s and the hotel.
  - iii. Provide nearbylocal accommodation (3 star or above including meals) and transport for JRT instructors.
  - iv. Provide honorarium (as per JR guidelines) for the instructors conducting theworkshops, and for the consultants setting up the skills lab (if requested)

- i. Space, skill trainers, consumables and support staff to conduct didactic and practical skills sessions.
- ii. AV equipment, High speed internet connection with WiFi access and IT support staff.
- iii. 30 affiliated certified JRT instructors (15 ECLS, 10 ENLS and 5 BCLS).
- iv. Host the first two JRT workshops under the supervision of JeevaRaksha faculty with in-house instructors for each module.
- v. Conduct at least 4 ECLS, 4 ENLS and 8 BCLS courses every two years.
- vi. At least 4 certified JeevaRaksha Instructors affiliated with the institute have to successfully organized and facilitated a JR workshop (as course directors) under the supervision of the JRT faculty

#### Miscellaneous

- A. The term ("Term") of this MoU shall commence as of the Effective Date (defined below) and shall expire in 5 years' time from the start date, unless earlier terminated or extended as provided herein. YENEPOYA (deemed to be)University, DERALAKATTE, and JEEVARAKSHA TRUST (each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties") may extend the Term of this MoU by a writing signed by both Parties. The exact number of scheduled visits shall be mutually agreed to by JRT and YENEPOYA (deemed to be) University, DERALAKATTE.
- B. If at any time during the Term either Party determines in its sole discretion that insufficient funding will be available to support such Party's activities or payment obligations under this MoU or that it is otherwise infeasible or impractical for such Party to continue to meet its obligations under this MoU, then such Party may terminate its participation in this MoU by providing not less than sixty (60) days' written notice to the other Parties. Such early termination shall not result in any liability to the terminating Party, but each Party agrees to comply with its obligations under this MoU that arose or accrued prior to the date of such termination.
- C. No Party will be responsible for any failure or delay in its performance under this MoU (except for the payment of money) due to causes beyond its reasonable control, including, but not limited to, labour disputes, strikes, lockouts, shortages of or inability to obtain labor, energy, raw materials or supplies, war, acts of terror, riot, acts of God or governmental action.
- D. In assuming and performing the obligations of this MoU, the Parties are each acting as independent parties and no Party shall be considered nor represent itself as a joint venture, partner, agent or employee of any other Party.
- E. If any disputes arise between any of the Parties in connection with this MoU, the Parties shall attempt to resolve such disputes through amicable negotiations. If such dispute is

Such mediation may be held via Skype or other video conferencing technology acceptable to the Parties and the costs of mediation, including the costs of the mediator, if any, shall be shared equally by the Parties.

F. Any modification or amendment to this MoU shall be in writing and signed by all Parties.






**Report of JeevaRaksha Emergency Nursing & Life Support (ENLS)

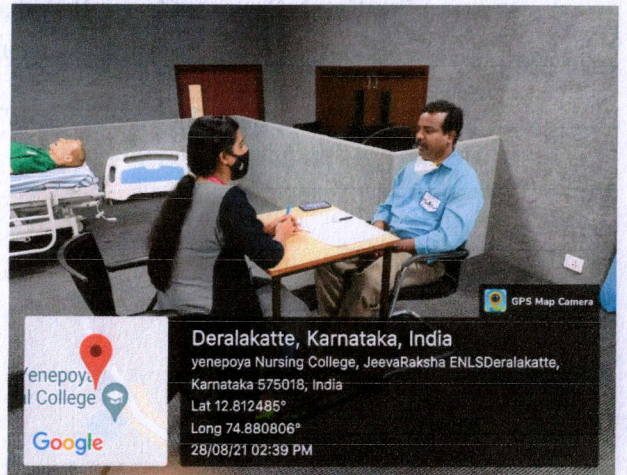
Figure 2: Addressing the gathering by Dr. Leena KC

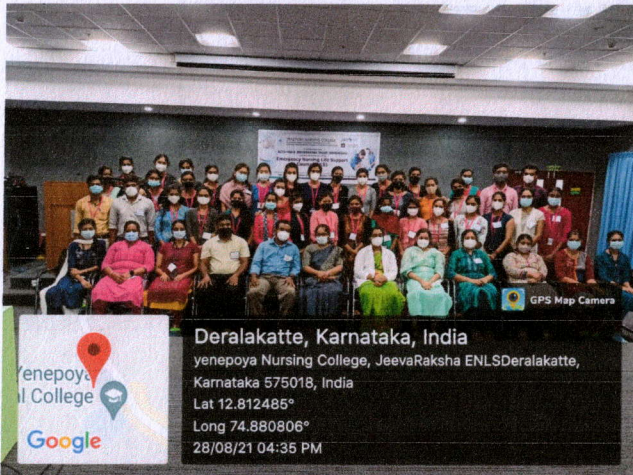
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**Figure 3: Airway skill station**



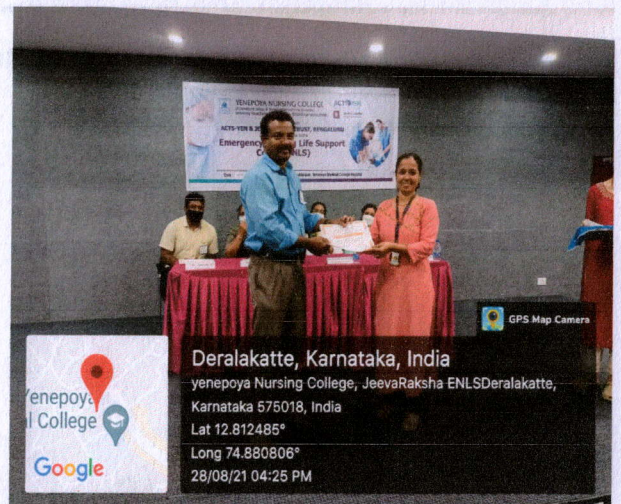
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**Figure 4: Communication skill station**




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**Figure 5: ENLS team with organizers**

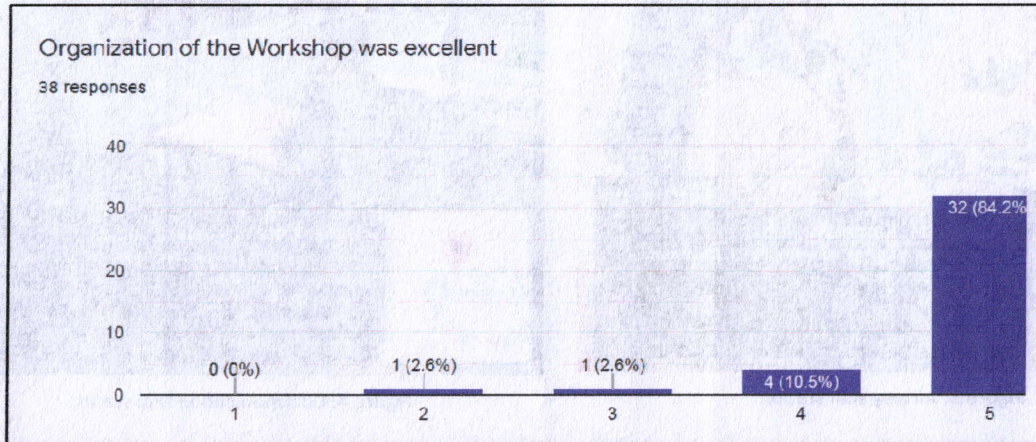


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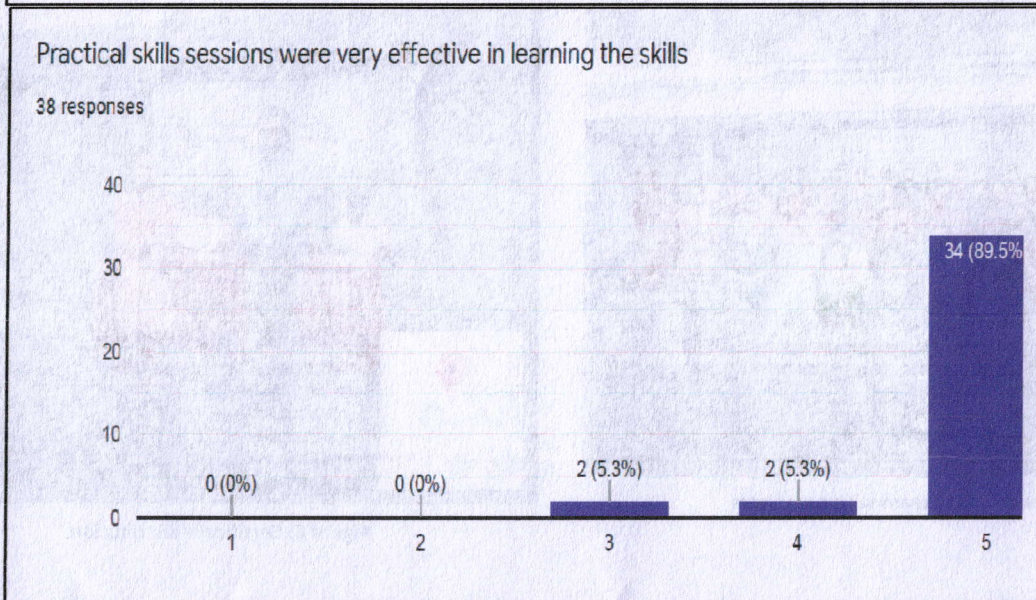
**Figure 6: Certificate distribution**
