Yenepoya Homoeopathic medical College & Hospital was established in the year 2018 as a constituent College of Yenepoya, Deemed to be University approved by Central Council of Homoeopathy, Ministry of AYUSH and by University Grant Commission, Govt. of India, for B.H.M.S. course with intake of 100 students from academic year 2018-19.

College is established at AYUSH campus that has natural beauty with eco-friendly environment. State of the art infrastructure and equipment are available at college. Well qualified, dedicated team of faculty members train students, making them competent to treat sick and restore health. The facilities available at institute are beyond norms. College is fully established with four laboratories, museum, demonstration room and department staff room i.e. Anatomy, Physiology including Biochemistry, Homoeopathic Pharmacy and Pathology including Microbiology. Eight Departments along with museum, demonstration room and department staff room i.e. Organon of Medicine and Homoeopathic Philosophy, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Repertory, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Surgery including Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, ENT and Dentistry, Practice of Medicine including Paediatrics and Community Medicine.

Homoeopathic Hospital with OPD and IPD section having 25 bed capacity is established in accordance to Regulations. Clinical facilities are further enhanced with four Geriatric and Palliative treatment units, one Rural health centre. Three Homoeopathic Specialty Treatment OPD in association with D.K. District AYUSH Department i.e. Srishti Homoeopathy Fertility Care, Manasa Mitra Children Homoeopathy Care, Araiike Homoeopathy Palliative Care. Homoeopathy OPD at Dept. of AYUSH unit Sajjipa.

Staff are actively involved in research program. Till now we have received 12 research proposals and six of them are approved and studies are in progress. Student research is also in progress. Creativity club for student gives ample scope for student to explore their talents. Latest Teaching methodologies are being adopted by faculty with creativity and innovations. Students performance at I-BHMS and II- BHMS University Examinations were between 80 to 92 percent. So far Faculty have published 70 scientific articles at various Homoeopathic Publications. Our faculties have been recognized with awards in the field of education.

We regularly observe and conduct curricular and co curricular programs for students and faculty, for exploring their knowledge and talent. 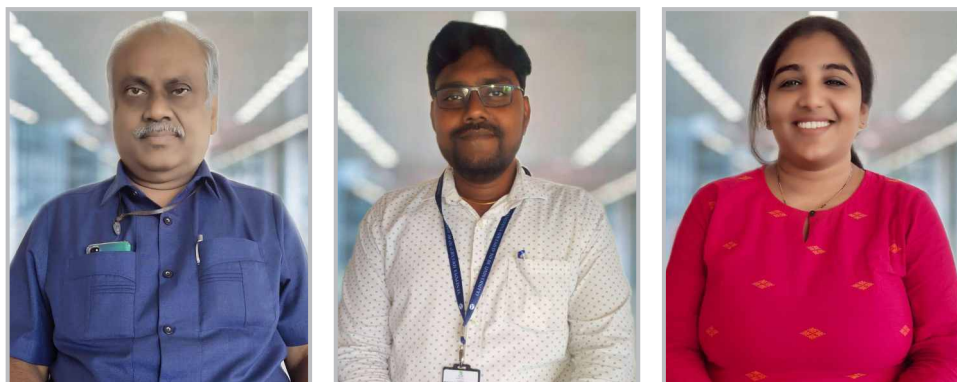
