This academic year onward the university has decided to implement the concept of NEP at the UG Degree level in order to facilitate students learning in a paced and flexible manner.

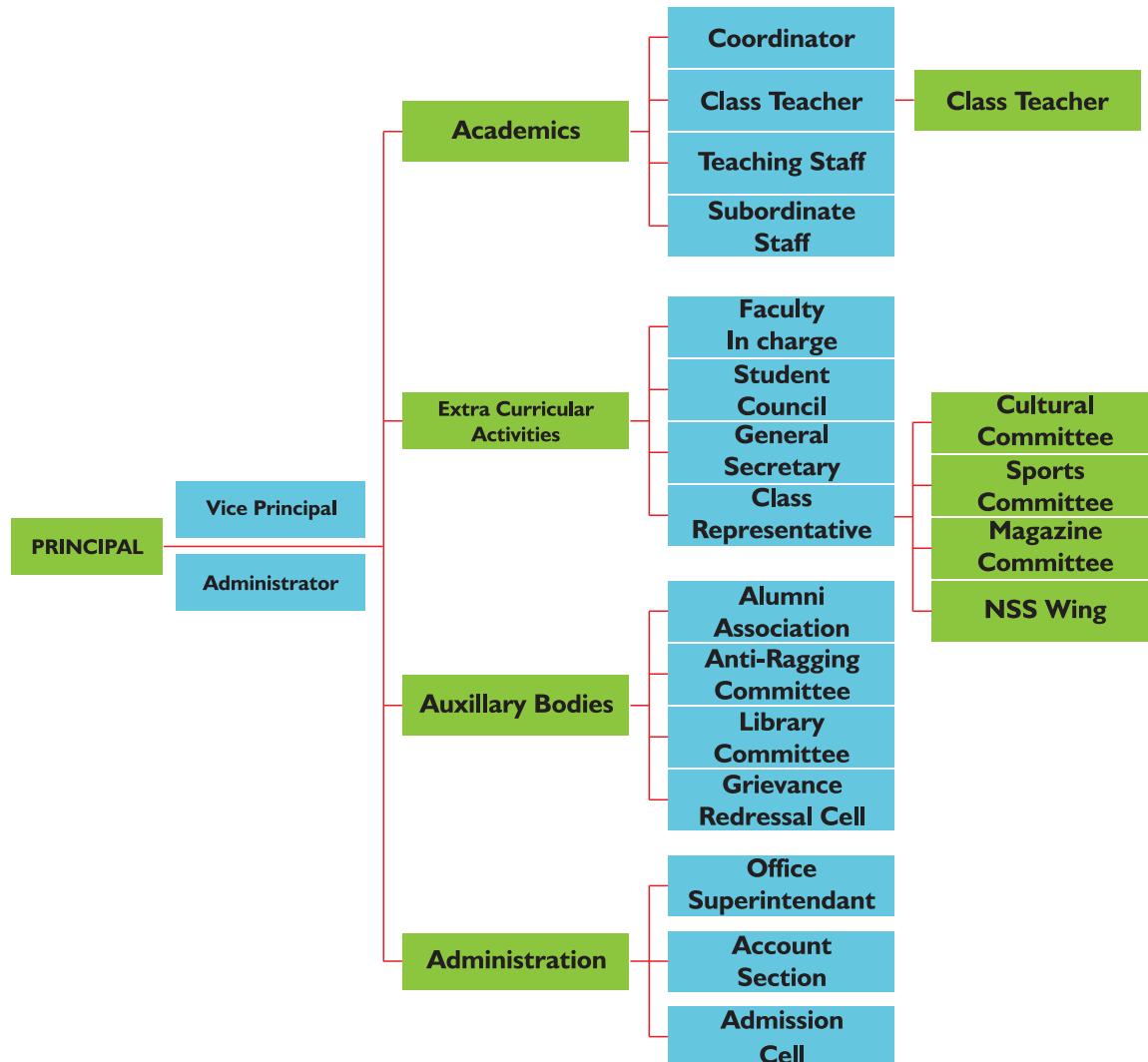

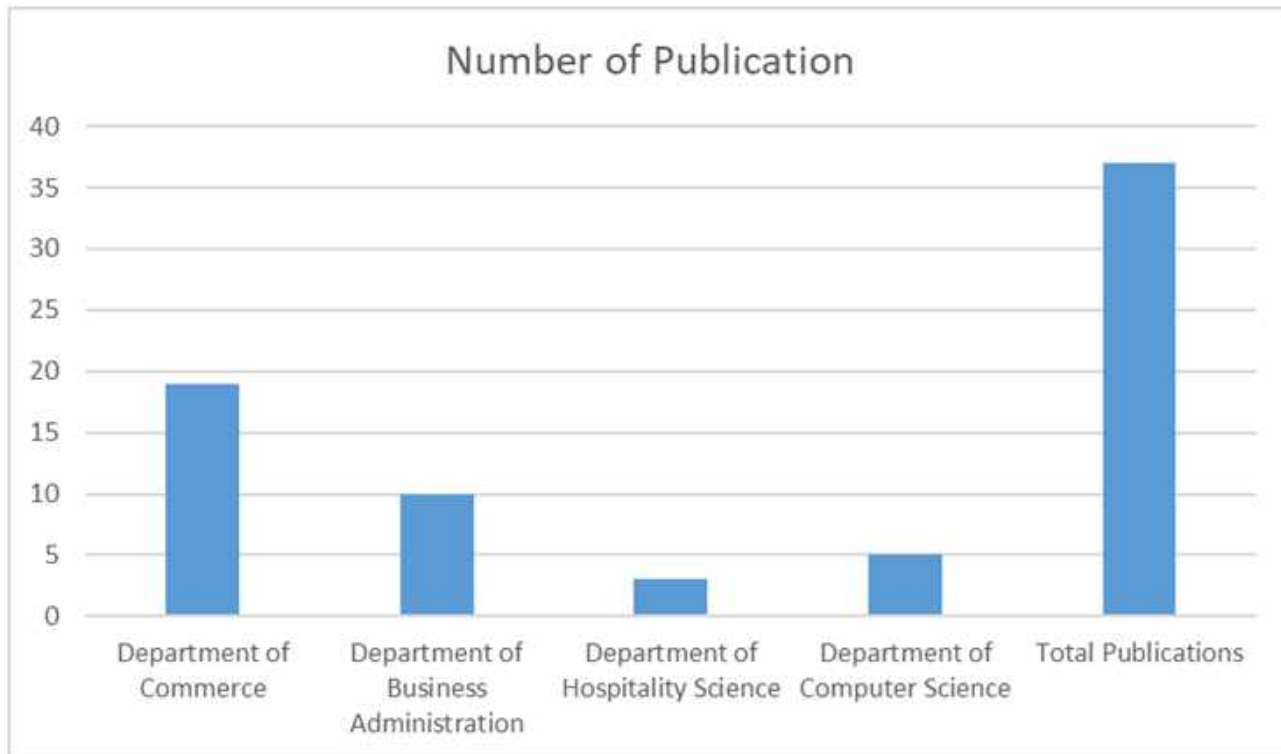
