Proposal to start Certificate course in Assessment and Management of Vestibular disorders in the Department of E.N.T.

The Proposal to start Certificate course in Assessment and Management of Vestibular disorders in the Department of E.N.T. was deferred with the following suggestions:

- Vestibular disorders include peripheral conditions like BPPV, Meniere's disease, cochlear otosclerosisetc and various central nervous system complex conditions.
- 2. There is gross disparity in the qualifications of learners varying between B.Sc. Audiology, BPT to DM
- No mention of which branch or specialty of MS and DM would be eligible amongst the medical faculty.
- A course should have learners with similar qualifications so that the trainer will adapt appropriate teaching learning methods and assessment for the learners.
- Course of 5-7 days may not be able to achieve desired objectives of such complex condictions and with such disparity in learner's qualification and competence.
- 6. List of books suggested should be in Vancouver format.
- 7. The department may consider having two courses:
  - a) One exclusively for medical personnel with MS in ENT or MD in Medicine (or equivalent) with experience in vestibular disorders or a candidate with super speciality degree DM in Neurology:
  - Second for technicians with few years of experience in vestibular or related field
