The sessions were:


Day 1 (25.08.18): IV Cannulization & Drug administration, Vital Signs, Bed Making & Positions ,Back /Oral Care,Wound Suturing, Lab Investigation.

Day 2 (26.08.18): Triage & Splinting of fractures, followed by Biomedical Waste Management , Bed bath, Catheterization, Oxygen Administration & Management , Ryles Tube Insertion and Universal Precautions

Day 3(27.08.18): ECG Introduction to crash cart & ACLS Protocol, Airway Management & Tracheotomy, Care of Dying & Last Death, NABH, Hospital Operation & Administration and Biomedical Equipments.

Day 4(28.08.18): Mobility & Exercise, Patient shift & transportation, ABG, Infection Control, Lumbar Puncture, Ventilator & ICU Skills, Chemotherapy, Pre-Post Operative Care & OT Skills, Orientation to Hemodynamic Monitoring, Dialysis Machine Management &

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Patient Care, Emergency room Management and Orientation to Virtual Reality (Endoscope, Laproscope, Cath Lab, and USG)

Day 5(30.08.18): AHA-Certified BLS Course

Day 6(31.08.18): PALS, Normal delivery and carrier guidance

Day 3(24.07.19): Hospital Operation & administration, ABG, NABH, Infection control, Biomedical Waste Management, Chemotherapy and Biomedical Equipments.

Day 4(25.07.19): First 50 students underwent AHA-Certified BLS Course and other 47 students underwent sessions on Labour management, Conducting normal delivery, PV examination, partograph recording, professional skills (Ethical / professional values,Dressing and grooming Being assertive, communication and managing stress) and Orientation to Virtual Reality (Endoscope, Laproscope, Cath Lab, and USG)

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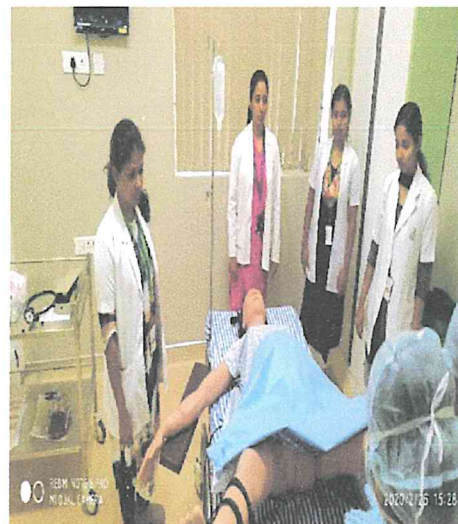
