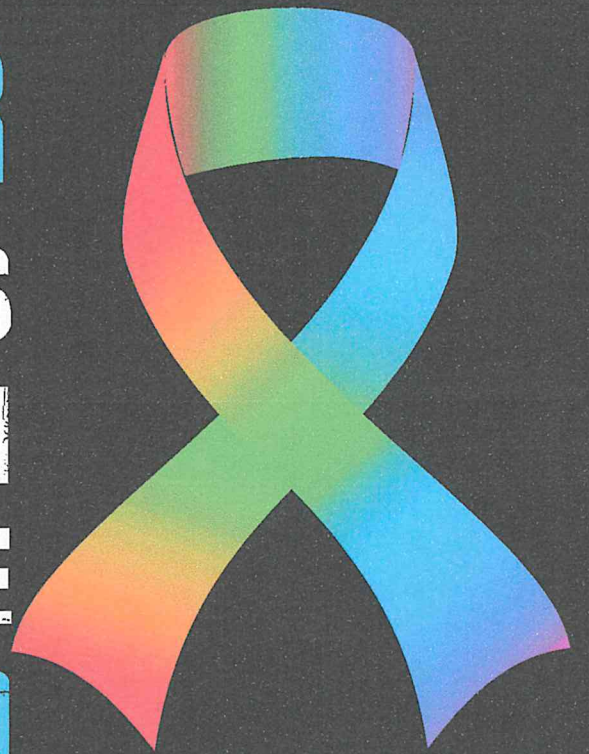

Cancer Awareness Outreach Programme (CAOP)

This document is a summary of the Cancer Awareness Outreach Programme & Early Diagnosis Initiatives for 2015-16. This project mainly focused on raising Cancer Awareness for NSS Volunteers & NSS Programme Officers of Dakshina Kannada, Kodagu & Udupi Districts. The projects covered a range of activities and including community outreach through student volunteers, communications, one-to-one conversations, and information services. This programme summary report provides an overview and initial analysis of the projects undertaken by CAOP

Need for the programme:

Cancer is an important public health problem in India. The incidence and prevalence of cancer is rapidly increasing in both developing and developed countries. Approximately 9.5 lakh Indian population suffering from cancer, out of which around 3.3 lakh males are suffering from lung cancer, oral cavity, Oesophagus, stomach and around 6.2 lakh females are suffering from breast, cervical, oral & Oesophageal cancer.

The most common cancers reported in India are breast and cervical cancers in females and lung and oral cancers in males. Over 62,000 women died in India due to cervical cancer in 2015 latest estimates by the ICMR. In 2008 cervical cancer was the most common cause of death due to disease among Indian Women. However 2012 report by WHO shows breast cancer upstaging cervical cancer as the most common in Indian women. Public awareness of cancer prevention can play its vital role in early diagnosis and treatment.

In view of this, University has undertaken Cancer Awareness Outreach Programme for the community through different organization like National Service Scheme (NSS), Nursing students and expanding towards Anganwadi workers focusing on awareness among rural population for early cancer detection with the leadership of Honorable Vice Chancellor Dr.M.Vijaykumar Onco-Surgeon. In the light of present knowledge early detection and prompt treatment of early cancer and pre cancers conditions provide the best possible protection against cancer for the individual and community.

Objectives:

- To create awareness about the risk factors and early clinical features of oral, cervical and breast and general caners.
- To inform people about the importance of early detection of cancer.
- To create awareness about facilities regarding cancer screening and treatment.
- To educate them about existing social security scheme with respect to cancer treatment.

Evolution of the Cancer Awareness

Outreach Programme:

Phase 1: Planing of the programme - At the 1st meeting we had discussion on how to go about the programme. Members suggested different organization like NSS, Lions Club, Inner wheel, Rotary club etc. At the begining we had mainly concentrated on training NSS Programme officers and volunteers of Dakshina Kannada, Udupi and Kodagu Districts with the aim that they are the ideal people to promote cancer awareness for the rural population through their special camp programme. We have taken initial step and around 9,000 NSS Volunteers & NSS Programme Officers trained under Yenepoya University since October 2015 to March 2016. So at the end of the July month our target to reach 13,500 NSS volunteers through which the university hopes to reach out educating 13.5-lakh people by March 2017. Our talk on Cancer Awareness equip and empower trainees building their knowledge, skills and confidence to talk about the cancer for the rural population.

Phase 2 : Formulation of the Committee under Yenepoya University

Officially on 19th of August 2015 we formed committee, as per the norms of Yenepoya University following members are in the committee.

A Programme Chief patron, Patron, Chairman, Convenor, Coordinators and members NSS Programme Officers were appointed to establish a cancer awareness and early diagnosis work stream, in order to improve population outcome from cancer locally and to make cancer more of a priority for those working in community health.

Phase 3: Identification of organization:

In Each Meeting all the members of the CAOP have given different suggestions for conducting the programme. The suggestions were to conduct awareness for NSS Volunteers, NSS Programme

Officers, Different NGO's, Rotary Inner wheels, Lions Club, Rotary Clubs organizations and Industrial Workers, Youth Organization,& Rural Community .

Phase 4: Development of training Module:

On 25th August 2015 we had conducted meeting with Honourable V.C who had suggested to prepare module for Breast, Cervical, Oral & on General Cancer accordingly the task has been divided by the team and worked on it.

Phase 5: Critical review, test run validation of module etc.

On 10th September 2015 we had presented the module of all the four cancers and also test trial done with the presence of house keeping staffs and accepted their suggestions and modified. Critical review, pretest, validation of module and translation into local languages has been done .

Phase 6: Translation of module into different local languages

On 28th September ,content of the module finalized and planned to edit in a different languages like tulu, Konkani, Beary, Malayalum, Kannada and Hindi and in future to distribute the CD to all the programme officers and NSS Volunteers those who have participated in the training programme. Through this Information on CD NSS Volunteers give awareness to the community. As per our plan CD contains short film on cancer awareness, dignitaries messages, Message from the celebrities and the ppt on breast cervical, oral and general cancers in different languages.

Phase 7: Launching of the CAOP

The Yenepoya University Cancer Awareness Outreach Programme launched on October 1st 2015 at Indoor Auditorium Yenepoya University Campus and organized programme for NSS Programme officers of Dakshina Kannada Kodagu and Udupi District.

Phase 8: Training NSS Programme Officers (135 in number)

On October 1st organized one day training programme for NSS Programme Officers & aims to ensure that this work is taken forward effectively. Chief guest for the programme was Dr.Rajeshwari devi District surgeon wenlok Govt. hospital, Mangalore. All the programme officers have been divided into different groups and given talk in smaller group and there was a interactive session with Vice chancellor Dr.M Vijayakumar followed by guest talk. Most of the NSS Programme Officers were happy about the programme and said this kind of programme is very useful for them and they are trained well to create awareness among rural people at their adopted village. Around 58 NSS Programme Officers participated in this programme.

On January 21st 2016 Yenepoya University organized the workshop on Cancer Awareness Outreach Programme at Yenepoya University for the NSS Programme officers of the Mangalore University. Around 98 NSS Programme Officers participated in the programme. Chief guest Mr.Arun Pujar Regional Director NSS, Govt of India, Mentioned in his talk that NSS Volunteers and programme officers must take the initiation to promote awareness among population especially in the rural people and to help them understand the importance of detecting cancer at an early stage and cure.

Prof .TD Kemparaju Registrar of Mangalore University explained every youth should undergo this training as they are budding Citizens of India Through them we can easily reach to the community. Dr.Gananath Shetty State Liasion Officer said through Yenepoya University this programme should reach all over the population in the country and he said surely it is going to happen. Dr.CV Raghuvveer, Registrar of Yenepoya University in his presidential address explained the aims and objectives of the programme he also said Cancer Awareness Programme team of the Institute aims to train health care providers, students, teachers, NGOs, NSS Programme Officers. Most of cases could be reduced if its treated and detected at an early stage. Main objectives of the cancer awareness outreach programme is to create awareness of the disease, mainly the breast cancer, oral cancer cervical cancer and general cancer and to help people recognize the early symptoms of cancer, thus enabling them to seek treatment at an early stage. To educate people about the key risk factor of cancer since most of it can be prevented by modifying lifestyle or avoiding the risk factor. To inform people about the importance of cancer check up at an early stage and to motivate them to avail of cancer check up services at nominal cost through Govt. Schemes. We had focus group discussion with the 93 NSS Programme officers of Mangalore University where they said, this kind of awareness is very essential for them. Participants had lot of quires which is explained by the speakers Dr. Rachana Prabhu Dr.Ashwini Shetty, Dr. Pracheth, Dr.Iriene, Members of the CAOP team. Dr.Vineetha Rai, NSS Coordinator of Mangalore University was present on the dias. She has planned the future programme for the 13,500 volunteers at this programme.

Phase 10: Educating community through NSS volunteers in their adopted villages

As per the Ministry of Youth affairs and sports each NSS volunteer must attend special camp once in a year. In this camp each trained NSS volunteer will be educating 100 members at the village which will reach out completing educating 13,50,000 members which is our target. All the NSS volunteers armed with CD containing short film, messages from dignitaries and celebrities, slides on different symptoms and sign, causes, test for early detection, for oral breast cervical and general cancers, Govt schemes etc.
