She also highlighted that the skills learnt in the program will help the students to use in the daily lives to save the life of others in emergency situation. 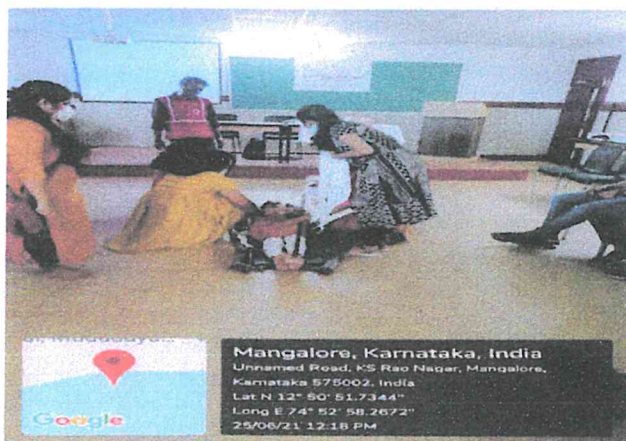


Figure 3: Day 2 training for students
