NOTE ON ITS ACTIVITIES

Background

The Hyderabad Cleft Society (HCS) was registered in 2000 as a society (Registration Number 8836 of 2000 registered under the Andhra Pradesh Societies-Regulation Act with the Government of Andhra Pradesh) primarily to give free treatment options to patients with facial defects who could not afford the high costs associated with treatment procedures required for the face. It has received permission under the FCRA from the Home Ministry to receive funding from foreign donor agencies (FCRA number 010230597 with the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India).

This service required entering into collaboration with a hospital and its associated infrastructure to provide such treatment. These clinical services are provided by GSR Hospitals.

The GSR Hospital is a registered 50 bedded hospital exclusively catering to patients with cleft and craniofacial abnormalities (Registration number 07-APMCE-0112 registered under the Andhra Pradesh Allopathic Private Medical Care Establishment Registration and Regulation Act of 2002 by the Health, Medical and Family Welfare Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh and Membership Number HYB/GO95/2008 admitted as a life member, Andhra Pradesh Private Hospitals and Nursing Homes Association). The hospital performs an average of 1,600 (1,000 primary surgeries) cleft and craniofacial surgeries every year.

The GSR hospital has been established in its present premises in May 2005. The Hospital is completely geared up to do cleft and craniofacial surgeries with the following infrastructure.

The aim of the collaboration between HCS and GSR Hospital is to provide world class infrastructure for patient care and free or low cost treatment options for patients.

#### Work done at GSR Hospital


A wide variety of facial defects are treated at the GSR Hospital. These include the following

1. Cleft Defects: Cleft Lip, Cleft Palate, Alveolar Bone Grafting, Cleft Rhinoplasty, Redo Palatoplasties, and Revision Surgeries for improperly done cleft surgeries etc.
2. Craniofacial Defects: These are very major defects of the head and neck region that require the services of a large group of doctors of various specialties.
3. Temporomandibular Joint (TMJ) Surgeries: TMJ Defect Surgeries are performed on children with fused jaws.
4. Tumor surgeries: Tumor surgeries for benign tumors and vascular malformations of the head and neck region are done for patients who cannot afford treatment in larger hospitals.
5. Esthetic Surgeries: Esthetic surgeries like jaw and nose surgeries are done for poor or middle class patients who cannot afford the same surgeries in other hospitals

#### Social Responsibility

1. Cleft Defects:

- a. Children born with cleft defects need multiple surgeries and care right from birth till they are 18 years old. Such children are usually born in

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households that live below the poverty line and their parents need the help of the medical fraternity to ensure a normal childhood. These children need multiple surgeries and procedures like 4 surgeries to correct the defects, speech therapy and orthodontic treatment. The children and their parents need psychological counseling to bring them from the periphery of society into mainstream society.

- b. The GSR Hospital provides free treatment to such children in the form of free counseling, surgeries at appropriate times, speech therapy and orthodontics. The GSR Hospital also provides free transportation from the rural areas of the state to and from the hospital by its own bus of public transport wherever possible.
- c. The GSR Hospital and HCS also collect donations from patients who wish to do so and can afford to do so, so that more children who cannot afford anything can be treated free of cost.

## 2. Craniofacial Defects:

- a. Children born with such defects usually cannot survive into adulthood without surgical aid. Even if they do make it to adulthood they are so badly deformed that they are ostracized from society.
- b. Such surgeries are done under high surgical risk and need very good corresponding infrastructure.
- c. The GSR Hospital provides free treatment for such children.

## 3. TMJ Surgeries:

- a. Children with TMJ defects have their upper and lower jaws fused so that they cannot open their mouth to eat or drink properly.
- b. Such children are a high risk group who are extremely mal nourished and under weight.
- c. The GSR Hospital provides free treatment for such children

## 4. Tumor surgeries:

- a. Benign tumors and vascular malformations of the head and neck region are fairly common in India
- b. Some of them do present a moderate to high risk for the patient.
- c. Such patients are treated free of cost at the GSR Hospital

## 5. Esthetic Surgeries:

- a. In India a lot of importance is given to girls with crooked or broken noses and badly formed jaws.
- b. Their acceptance into society is jeopardized because of the way they look.
- c. The GSR Hospital provides low cost options for such patients to improve their nose and jaw defects.

## Infrastructure

1. Two well equipped operation theaters that include GE Aespire anesthesia work stations with Isoflurane and Sevoflurane vaporizers, GE 8 channel cardiac and invasive monitors with all parameters including measuring ETCO2, GE Steris Operating lights, all necessary instruments for running a high volume cleft center, centralised oxygen supply and other equipment that include a GE defibrillator, Carl Zeiss Operating Microscope, 3.5 mm Fibre optic flexible nasal endoscope, a nerve stimulator, a Johnson and Johnson peizo electric surgical system, Harmonic Scalpel, three Stryker bone cutting system in India, Leibinger, Martin and Synthes implant systems.
2. Six bed post operative ICU that has individual non-invasive GE 4 channel monitors for 5 beds and an Invasive GE 8 channel monitor for one bed. The ICU is also equipped with a neo-natal Siemens Engstrom ventilator, a GE defibrillator, centralized oxygen and a portable X-ray unit.
3. Thirty four bed general ward area for patients with all amenities that include a kitchen and rest rooms.
4. A fully equipped speech therapy unit with aerophonoscope, nasal endoscope and nasometry with Dr. Speech software.
5. A fully equipped dental and orthodontic therapy center with dental chair and required instrument to perform all dental surgery.
6. A digital orthopantomogram system that can take OPG's and lateral cephalograms.
7. A fully equipped photography department with state of the art cameras and other equipment required to photograph patients.
8. A fully equipped IT department with a locally developed database to store all patient information.

### Funding

The HCS has procured funds for establishing the best infrastructure and trained personnel to treat patients with defects of the head and neck. To give free or low cost treatment for patients the HCS raises money from different sources outside and within India. Even patients who have been treated at the GSR Hospital contribute to help future patients who cannot afford anything.

3. Funding for personnel and marketing

- a. Since all personnel are employed on a full time basis, they need to be given a salary at par with other private sector hospitals. These expenses for salaries are adjusted in the treatment grant and they are clearly explained to the donor organizations or individuals concerned.
- b. Marketing expenses are also needed to spread the message of the Society and to raise money both in India and abroad.
- c. Regular lectures and presentations are made in India and abroad to raise money and to give updates to all stake holders.
- d. Symposiums and conferences are organized so that more people can be trained in this field to set up more units like the HCS to treat more people.

4. Funding for research

- a. The HCS/GSR Hospital has tied up with universities in Netherlands, USA, UK, Germany, Switzerland, Belgium, Italy etc. to do various research activities in the field of cleft and craniofacial surgery.

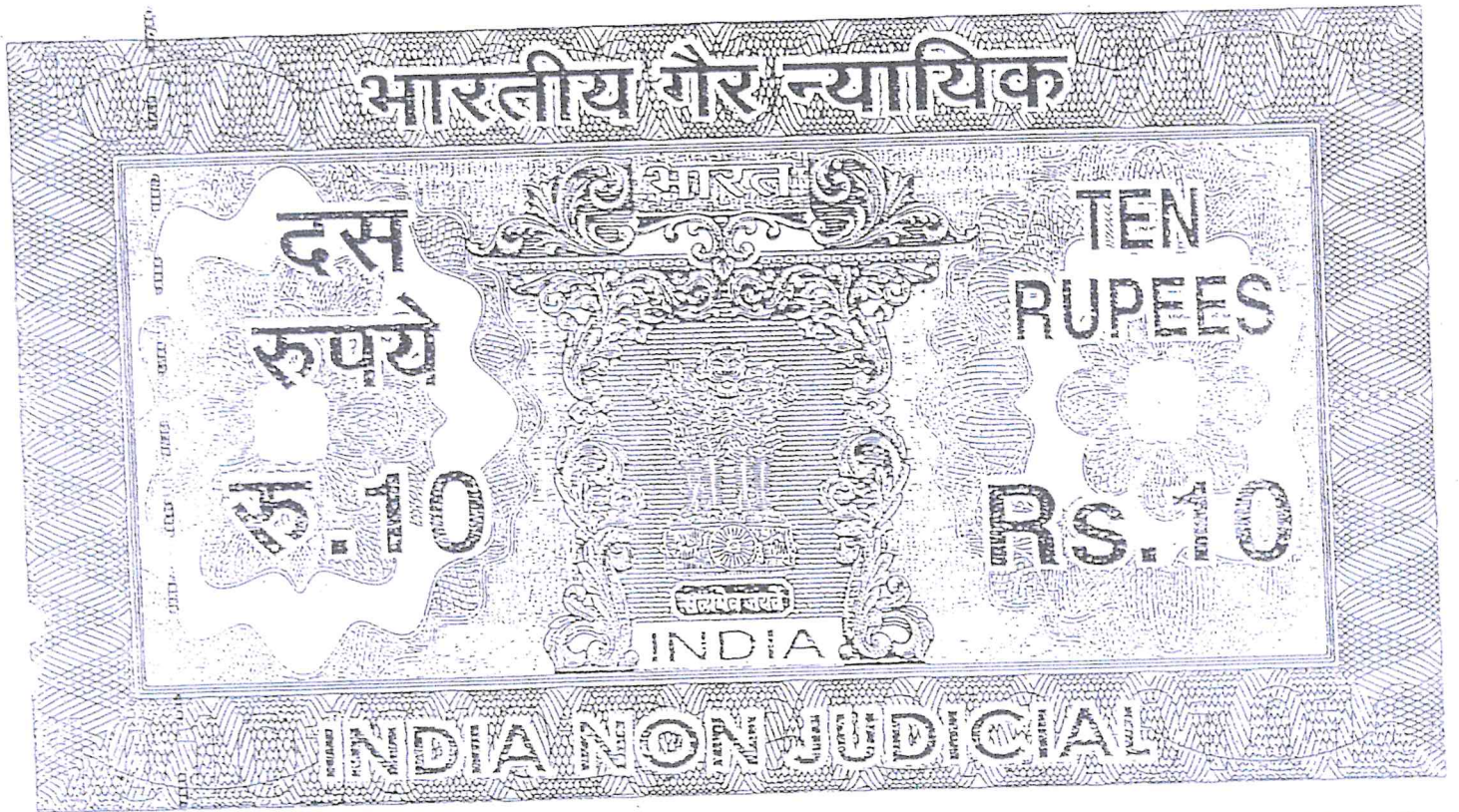
