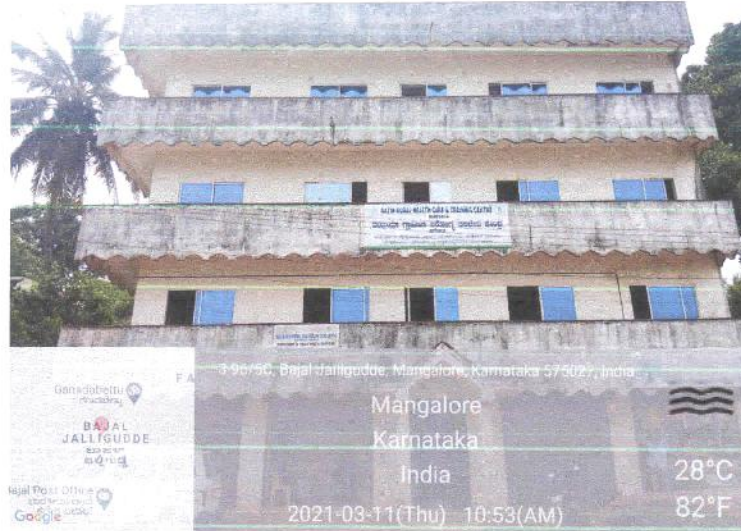

## RAZIA RURAL HEALTH CARE AND TRAINING CENTER, HAREKALA



Razia Rural Healthcare and Training Center (RHTC), Harekala is located at a distance of about 12 kms from Yenepoya Medical College, Deralakatte. The population covered by RHTC is about 30,045 across five village Panchayat areas namely Harekala, Pavor, Amblamogaru, Boliyar and Phajeer. Residential facilities are provided separately for Male and Female interns in a total of six rooms. The residential facility is attached with a mess and a dining area. There is a full time cook for cooking food to the interns posted during the day and night. There is an air conditioned room with attached washroom for the medical officer posted for night duties. There is a television in the common area for recreation. The center provides outpatient department and referral services on a 24x7 basis supported by emergency ambulance services free of cost. Other health care services include basic laboratory services, dental and physiotherapy clinics. Specialty services from the department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics are provided on a weekly basis. Immunization sessions for under five children and pregnant women are conducted once in a fortnight in collaboration with Primary Health Center, Innoli.

The outreach services are delivered in the form of camps at eight fixed sites in the panchayat areas on Wednesday and Saturday every month. School health services at five government schools are also a part of the outreach services. National health programmes are implemented in the field practice area in collaboration with district health and family welfare department. The center is currently implementing the Health and Demographic Survey in its field practice area. Around 1250 families in and around the RHTC area are being provided with free specialty treatment including surgeries and post operative surgical care at Yenepoya Medical College hospital.

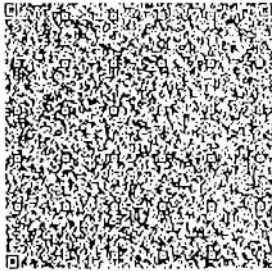

01.04.2015 to 31.03.2020.


Statutory Alert:





