



1. Campus Interview

- A campus interview was organized on 21 July 2019 by the BLK hospital, New Delhi for the outgoing batch (2015-19) of B.Sc Nursing students. A written test was conducted by the recruitment team after which interview was conducted. Among 80 students, 56 students were selected and job offer letters were given.
- A campus interview was organized on 22 July 2019 by Fortis Escorts hospital, New Delhi for the outgoing batch (2015-19) of BSc Nursing students. Mrs. Minimole John, Chief of Nursing and Tanu Guati H.R.Assistant Manager, Fortis Escorts hospital conducted the interview. A written test was conducted by the recruitment team after which interview was conducted. Out of 77, 50 students were selected and the job offer letters were given.
- A campus interview was organized on 29 July 2019 by Yashodha Hospital Hyderabad for the outgoing batch (2015-19) of BSc Nursing students. Mr. Dinesh Kumar, Manager and Mrs. Meera Augustine, Chief Nursing Officer conducted the interview. All 70 students were selected and were offered with job letter.



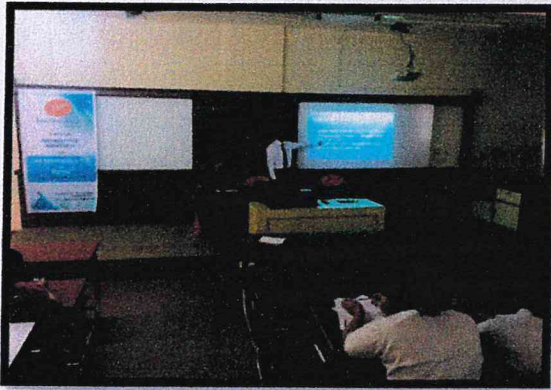


Figure 1 Seminar on career guidance

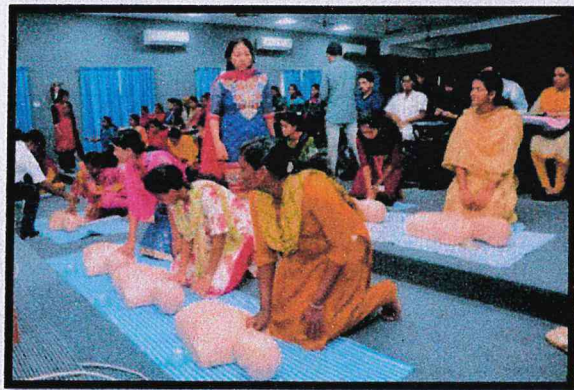




Figure 2 Workshops on BLS


Figure 2 Seminar on Overseas Opportunities
