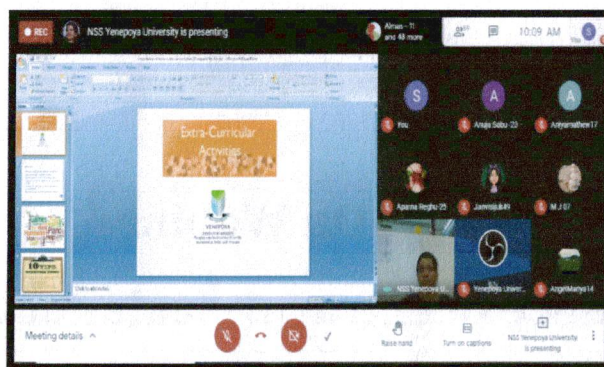


Figure 1-Resource person explaining about importance of extracurricular activities
