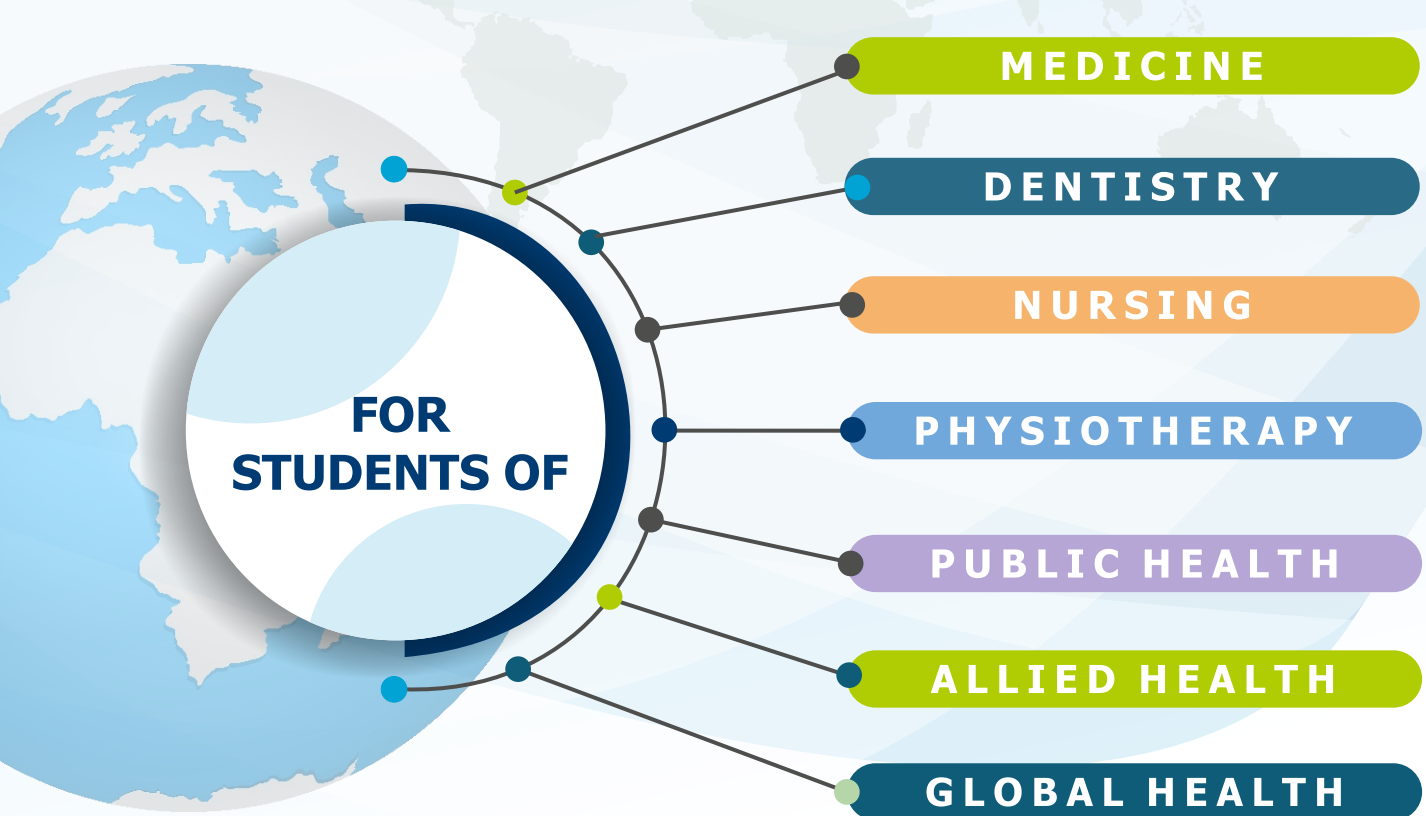




Community Health Immersion in India

Short-Term International Visitorship



(1 WEEK DURATION)

Available throughout the year

Programme Outcome:

By the end of the visit, students will be able to:

- Understand the healthcare governance framework in India and its role in healthcare delivery.
- Recognise the importance of community participation and stakeholder engagement in improving healthcare access and services.
- Gain insights into the challenges faced by healthcare providers at various levels.
- Networking with local students and healthcare professionals

Activities:

Overview of India's Healthcare System

The programme will cover India's healthcare system from the grassroots to the top level. A field visit to key healthcare infrastructure will be organized to understand the functions and challenges involved in service delivery. The visit will include:

- Sub-centres and Primary Health Centres
- Urban and Rural Health Centres
- Community Health Centres
- District TB Office, District Vector-Borne Disease Office, IDSP (Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme), etc.
- Dental, multi-speciality and super-speciality hospital
- Tertiary care oncology center
- Complementary medicine hospitals (Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Naturopathy and Yoga)

Visit to Anganwadi Centres and Interaction with Health Workers

Students will visit Anganwadi Centres and interact with ASHA (Accredited Social Health Activists) workers and ANMs (Auxiliary Nurse Midwives) to understand the role of grassroots health workers and their contributions to community health.

Public-Private Collaboration in Healthcare

The Indian healthcare system is a blend of public and private services aimed at providing healthcare to all sections of society. The programme will highlight the collaboration between non-governmental organizations (NGOs), private medical colleges, and public organizations, particularly in strengthening healthcare services for vulnerable populations and high-risk groups.

Challenges Faced by Vulnerable Groups

Students will gain insights into the challenges experienced by beneficiaries, especially vulnerable groups, through visits to urban slums, tribal communities, and migrant populations.

Understanding Government Healthcare Schemes

The programme will also introduce students to the utilization and benefits of various national health schemes, such as:

- Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY)
- Janani Shishu Suraksha Yojana (JSSY)
- Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana (SSY)
- Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY)
- Rashtriya Kishor Swasthya Karyakram (RKSK)
