Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, chaired the meeting, welcomed all the IQAC members and requested the IQAC Coordinator to present the agenda for the meeting:-

Subject 1:

Approval of the minutes of the 22nd IQAC meeting held on 3rd January 2022

Discussion: The minutes of the 22nd meeting of the IQAC held on 3rd January 2022 was placed before the members for formal approval.

Resolution: Resolved to approve the minutes of the 22nd meeting of the IQAC held on 3rd January 2022.

Subject 2:

Action taken report on the resolutions/decisions taken in the 22nd meeting of the IQAC held on 3rd January 2022.

Discussion: The action taken report on the resolutions/decisions taken on the 22nd meeting of IQAC held on 3rd January 2022 was presented by the IQAC Coordinator and sought the approval of the members on the actions taken.

Resolution: It was resolved to approve the action taken report of the 22nd IQAC meeting held on 3rd January 2022.

Subject 3:

Update on status of SSR submission to NAAC:

Discussions: IQAC Coordinator informed that the SSR was submitted to NAAC on 17th of December 2021 and the Student Satisfaction Survey completed on 16th January 2022. DVV clarifications were received from NAAC twice on 20th February 2022 and 22nd March 2022. IQAC Coordinator also informed that the responses on the queries had been submitted by the University on 5th and 24th March 2022 respectively, and the same had been accepted by NAAC as per the information available on NAAC portal.

Resolution: The status update of the SSR submission to NAAC was apprised to the members.

Subject 4:

Update on Mentorship program:

Discussions: It was brought to the notice of the members that the Mentor allotment orders (2021-2022) for the Institutions of Yenepoya Nursing College, Yenepoya College of Allied Health Sciences, Yenepoya Pharmacy College and Research Centre, Yenepoya Physiotherapy College, Yenepoya Institute of Arts, Science, Commerce & Management and Yenepoya Naturopathy College & Yogic Sciences had been prepared and dispatched. However, the admissions for the programs, which were under the ambit of NEET, were not complete and Mentor allotment notifications, were pending for Yenepoya Medical College,

Yenepoya Dental College, Yenepoya Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital and Yenepoya Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital.

Resolution: The status on the Mentorship program was apprised to the IQAC members.

Subject 5:

Progress on NEP 2020

Discussions: IQAC Coordinator informed that UGC had mandated implementation of National Education Policy 2020 for all Higher Education Institutions. In this direction, Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) had already started offering undergraduate programs (B.Com, BBA) compliant with the NEP from the academic year 2021-2022. Further, to meet the requirements of NEP, the coordinator informed that the University had already registered with Academic Bank of Credit for credit accumulation, redemption and transfer of credits. In view of this achievement it was suggested that the University could expand the scope of implementation of NEP to other programs conducted in the YIASCM and School of Allied Health Sciences. Further, he added that these institutions had already started working on the modalities of developing appropriate curriculum for each program keeping in mind the exit provisions permitted in NEP. The details of these would be deliberated in the Board of Studies before it is brought for approval by Academic Council and Board of Management.

Resolution: The members of the cell appreciated the initiatives taken by the University and the progress achieved for effective implementation of NEP.

Subject: 6

Introduction of Apprenticeship/Internship embedded Degree Programme:

Discussions: Guidelines for Higher Education Institutions to offer Apprenticeship/Internship embedded Degree Programme issued by UGC were taken up for discussion.

The coordinator IQAC briefed on the feasibility of introducing Apprenticeship/ Internship embedded Degree Programme in the programs conducted at Yenepoya Institute of Arts, Science, Commerce and Management and Yenepoya School of Allied Health Sciences which is offering wide range of vocational undergraduate programs. He suggested that the University could consider starting of these programs from the academic year 2022-2023.

Prof. Kunhikrishnan enquired whether the University had any industrial collaboration to implement internships and apprenticeship and the nature of MoUs signed by the University. Dr. Arun, IQAC coordinator stated that University had entered into collaborations with 10 organizations (Hospitals and industries) to meet the requirements of the programs envisioned by UGC. He further briefed on the advances made in this regard and the nature of involvement of the organizations in introducing the apprenticeship/ Internship embedded Degree Programme. In response to the query raised by Prof. Kunhikrishnan about the curriculum development and the involvement of the organizations in the process Dr. Arun explained that there would be special invitees from these organizations during the preparation of the regulations and curriculum. He added that some of the Institutions were already conducting certificate programs and were aware of the requirement of conducting an academic program. The draft of the curriculum would be prepared and scrutinized by the experts with the help of the Directorate of curriculum of Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) before the curricula are placed for approval of the Academic Council.

Resolution: The members of IQAC felt that the University could consider the introduction of apprenticeship/ Internship embedded Degree Programme from the academic year 2022-2023 after preparing the timeline for achieving the necessary prerequisites on time.

Subject 7:

Establishment of Research Development Cell (RDC):

Discussions: IQAC Coordinator presented the gist of the UGC guidelines dated 14th March 2022, for Establishment of Research & Development Cell in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs).

He pointed out that Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) had been practicing several of these guidelines since 2010 and had achieved laudable credentials in research activities. He felt that the University could consider the establishment of the RDC as per UGC guidelines. He reiterated that the cell Director would be acting as an overarching Officer and the various sections could function reasonably in a decentralized manner. Hon. Vice Chancellor sought

the opinion of Dr. Rekha P.D., Director, YRC and Dr. Vina Vaswani, Director, CFE. In response both of them consented to align the activities of various centers to meet the objectives of RDC. However, they opted for a detailed discussion to decide on the future course of action in this direction.

Resolution: The suggestions of the Directors of Yenepoya Research Centre and Centre for Ethics were considered favorably and it was decided that the University would take necessary steps for establishment of Research Development Cell in the University.

Subject 8:

Renewal of NABH accreditation to the teaching Hospital:

Discussions: The Coordinator informed about the status of the renewal application for NABH accreditation. He said that NABH had granted extension of the validity of the accreditation till 30th June 2022 and all the requirements for renewal of accreditation had been complied including the payment of annual fee. The Hospital quality section had been continuously involved in the annual training and induction programs to achieve the required bench marks towards equipping the hospital staff to meet the NABH norms and the renewal assessment was scheduled from 13th, 14th, and 15th of May 2022.

Resolution: The status on the renewal of NABH accreditation was apprised to the IQAC members as above.

Subject 9:

Approval of Quality Manual along with Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for Internal Quality Assurance Cell.

Discussions: The IQAC Coordinator informed the members that University has been persistently striving to create an environment appropriate to infuse quality in all its activities. In order to effectively achieve this, an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established in 2010 and several quality initiatives were emplaced to ensure high standard in the performance of the University. Further to streamline the activities of the IQAC (with 10 constituent units under the ambit of the University), a quality manual has been prepared with

policy documents encompassing Vision and Mission and objectives of IQAC, Constitution of the Internal Quality Assurance Units at constituent colleges and IQAC Policy, Quality assurance strategies, Review of action plan/strategy implementation. He called for inputs from the members.

Resolution: Resolved that the Quality Manual be adopted.

Subject 10:

Logo for Internal Quality Assurance Cell of YDU:

Discussions: The Coordinator briefed on the need for designing a logo for IQAC and the strategy adopted for the same. The members felt that the proposal was a requirement and suggested to proceed.

Resolution: Resolved to design a logo for IQAC, Yenepoya (Deemed to be University).

Subject 11:

Any other matter with the permission of the chair:

There was a general discussion on the functioning of the IQAC and preparations for the NAAC Peer Team visit.

The meeting concluded with the Vice Chancellor proposing the vote of thanks.
