

PREAMBLE




VISION




OBJECTIVES

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D. programs under various faculties are as follows:

Qualifications

✦ Medical and Dental :

Candidates with M.D., and M.S., or Medical P.G. Diploma, M.D.S., or M.Sc. in medical subjects, including M.Sc. in oncology & M.Sc. in Human Genetics are eligible for enrollment for Ph.D. course.

✦ Pharmacy:

Candidates with M.Pharm, Pharm D and Pharm- D (PB) degree awarded by a College/University recongnized by AICTE/PCI/RGUHS or a P.G. degree in Pharmacy are eligible for enrollment for Ph.D. course in Pharmacy of this University.

✦ Ayurveda:

Candidates with Ayurveda Vachaspathi (M.D. (Ayu)/ M.S. (Ayu) in Ayurveda) in all the specialties or an equivalent P.G. qualification awarded by any other College/University recognized by CCIM are eligible for enrollment for Ph.D. course in Ayurveda of this University.



✦ **Homeopathy:**

Candidates with M.D. in Homeopathy degree or an equivalent P.G. qualification awarded by a College /University recognized by CCH are eligible for enrollment for Ph.D. course in Homeopathy of this University.

✦ **Nursing:**

Candidates with M.Sc./M.Phil in Nursing degree or a P.G. Degree in Nursing considered as equivalent by Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) awarded by a College/University recognized by INC.

✦ **Arts, Science, Commerce, and Management:**

M.A. (Master of Arts), M.Sc. (Master of Science), M.Com (Master of Commerce), M.B.A. (after BA /B.Sc./B.Com), P.G. Diploma in Management of 2 year duration (after B.A./B.Sc./B.Com).





✦ Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. Programme with a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7- point scale are eligible to apply for Ph.D.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

Application Procedure


- ✦ **Application for admission for the Ph.D. program is made in the prescribed forms, which is made available at the office of the Registrar /website, www.yenepoya.edu.in**
- ✦ **The admission of the candidates involves two stages processes the entrance test and interview.**
- ✦ **The Entrance Test is conducted at the Yenepoya (deemed to be University) and the date is notified in advance.**
- ✦ **The syllabus of the Entrance Test consists of 50% of research methodology and 50% is subject specific.**
- ✦ **Candidates with a minimum of 50% in the entrance examination are considered as eligible for the interview**
- ✦ **An interview/viva voce is organized by the Ph.D. Admission committee constituted by the Yenepoya (Deemed to be University).**

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

Allocation of Research Supervisor

The allocation of Research Supervisor for a selected research scholar shall be decided by the Department based on the number of scholars per Research Supervisor and the available specialization among the Supervisors at the time of interview/ viva voce. In case of topics which are of inter disciplinary nature, a Co-Supervisor from outside the Department/ Faculty/College/Institution maybe allocated.

- ✦ **A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, is allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) / differently – abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC, or those who had obtained their Masters degree prior to 19th September, 1991**
 - ✦ **Candidates having no clear grading/marks in their Post Graduate examination are considered for the Ph.D. program subject to approval from the equivalence committee**
 - ✦ **A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non creamy layer) differently abled, other categories of candidates who have cleared the M.Phil., and candidates who have cleared the MD/MS/M Sc./DM/M.Ch/DNB/MDS Course**

PROGRAM STRUCTURE


The provisionally selected Ph.D. scholars are expected to do a Pre-Ph.D. coursework for one semester of 12 credits. The Pre-Ph.D. coursework is a preparation for the Pre-Ph.D. examination which is conducted after the coursework. The provisional registration is confirmed on successful completion of the Pre-Ph.D. examination.

The Ph.D. scholars submit a half yearly progress report every six months and the progress of the Ph.D. scholar is assessed every six months by the Doctoral Advisory Committee. The DAC permits the Ph.D. scholar to submit the rough draft of the thesis once, all the research objectives are completed, two original research articles related to the research are accepted/ published and two conference presentations are done. A pre-colloquium is conducted in presence of the DAC members followed by submission of the final synopsis and final thesis to the Controller of Examinations of the university. The thesis is adjudicated by one Indian and one foreign adjudicator. The viva voce is conducted in the presence of the Indian adjudicator followed by the public defense. The Ph.D. scholar is conferred the Doctor of Philosophy degree at the ensuing convocation whenever it is held next.

✦ Orientation for the Research Scholars and Research Supervisors

The Pre-Ph.D. coursework starts with an orientation program for the provisionally selected students and their research supervisors. An expert is invited to speak to the provisionally selected students at the orientation program.

✦ Workshops

Workshops are conducted regularly for supporting the Ph.D. scholars in various aspects of academic research writing. A total of 23 workshops were conducted from 2016-2025.

ANNUAL EVENTS

Assessment of the progress of the PhD scholars is done twice every year during the months of February-March and August-September in the presence of the Doctoral Advisory Committee.


