As a part of Swachhata Hi Seva, the following activities were observed by the Centre for Environmental Studies.

1) **Cleaning of campus:** The University Housekeeping department maintains an effective campus cleaning system regularly. A register was made to record the number of dustbins displayed in all buildings and common areas of the University campus. The dustbins are labeled for segregation of waste. This will help to maintain record of daily garbage collection and disposal.

3) Rain water harvesting: University has measures for rain water harvesting. A large rain water harvesting pond of two acres ensures underground water recharge. In addition 8 roof top harvesting systems have been installed from past one year. Water saving fixtures is fitted for conservation of water. Water audit is done on regular basis.

4) "Cleanest hostel room" contest

A contest on cleanest hostel room was organized for few hostel blocks of the University. The hostels were inspected by the judges and different criteria such as organization of books, clothes and slippers, no odour in the room, dustbins are emptied, no scattering, walls are tidy, bed spread and pillow case are clean and neat was examined. A total of 254 rooms were inspected and three rooms were selected for prizes in each block.
