The "World Environment Day" was celebrated on June 8th 2015 by organizing a workshop on "Vermicomposting" for the staff of the University. The resource person for the programme was Dr. Hareesh Joshy, an expert in vermitechnology. The participants were given hands on experience on setting the vermibin and explained the details on primary and secondary decomposition. The types of earthworms used in vermicomposting and the problems faced in the process were also elucidated. Yenepoya University has a well established vermicomposting unit in which the organic waste from the campus is used for decomposition. Approximately 300 Kg of vermicompost is being generated per month. The vermicompost is of high quality with good NPK value.
