Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who can apply for the Ph.D. programme?

Candidates who satisfy the eligibility requirements prescribed by the University and applicable regulatory authorities are eligible to apply.

2. Is the Ph.D. programme available in both full-time and part-time modes?

Yes. The University offers full-time and part-time doctoral programmes, subject to fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility criteria and regulations.

3. Is an online / offline entrance examination mandatory?

Eligible applicants may be required to appear for the University online / offline entrance examination unless exempted under the applicable regulations.

4. How are candidates selected?

Selection is based on the University's admission process, which may include eligibility screening, online / offline entrance examination (where applicable), and interview or research interaction.

5. Can working professionals pursue a Ph.D.?

Yes. Working professionals may apply under the part-time category, provided they satisfy the prescribed eligibility requirements and obtain the necessary approvals from their employer, where applicable.

6. How is a research supervisor assigned?

Research supervisors are allocated based on the scholar's area of research, faculty expertise, and availability of approved supervision capacity.

7. Is interdisciplinary research encouraged?
