2. And whereas Yenepoya University, promoted by Islamic Academy of Education trust, which has well known Medical, Dental, Nursing and Physiotherapy colleges where the University has now in its ambit the Medical, Dental and other Allied health science disciplines.
3. And whereas, St. Aloysius College and Yenepoya University, of which the Medical and other colleges are now part, wish to continue the common interests of the two colleges and further develop and enrich the academic and research exchanges between themselves.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITNESS AS FOLLOWS:




- A.

  - iii. Exchange of students
  - iv. Exchange of faculty and staff
- B. Each of the above activities will be governed by specific norms to be established between parties and coordinated by Ms.Bhavya D.K, Head, Postgraduate Department of Biochemistry on behalf of St.Aloysius College and Dr. S N Rao, Head of Department of Pharmacology on behalf of Yenepoya University.


- C. The above activities will be carried out in such a manner so as not to digress from the established traditions and regulations of each party.
- D. The terms of this MOU may be modified and amended from time to time upon agreement between the parties.
- E. This MOU shall be valid initially for a period of 5 years and be renewed automatically thereafter for a further period of five years unless notified thereto by either party within three months of expiry thereof.




