RECITALS

A. FF is a non-profit organization (trust) as defined by the laws of India duly organized, valid and in good standing under the laws of India and is entitled to carry on its activities as they are now being conducted. The main objective of FF is to treat, with cleft surgery of the highest standard, poor and needy persons throughout India who are suffering from congenital & facial deformities like Cleft Lip, Cleft Palate etc., which affect them not only cosmetically but also functionally and psychologically. For that purpose FF intends to fund centre for Cleft and Craniofacial anomaly so as to facilitate free treatment for patients with cleft lip and palate deformity.

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B. CFCFA is a reputed Research Centre in the Yenepoya University.

C. The parties, therefore, desire to enter into a cooperative, joint effort (the "Partnership") through which CFCFA will, in a phased manner, significantly augment its resources (operation theatres, post-operative wards, Para-medical staff, etc.) to substantially increase the number of cleft reconstruction surgeries, through financial, and other support from FF.

D. The purpose and details of the Partnership are described in Clause III (A) (1) to (4).

I. OBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

The object of this agreement is to set up the conditions of the cooperation between the parties and of the support and assistance provided by FF.

The contribution of FF to the cooperation consists in bearing the costs and expenses for the medical treatment and care of a certain number of persons suffering from congenital cleft lip and palate, who lack the means to pay these costs.

II. TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE

Funding of the partnership shall begin on 1st of august 2011 (the "Effective Date") and shall continue until 31st December 2011 (the "funding Period"), the contract will be renewed thereafter.

III. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

A. CFCFA

1. CFCFA shall engage the services of surgeons & anaesthetists empanelled by FF from amongst the doctors employed at Yenepoya University.
2. CFCFA shall make a full and thorough review of available resources at its Craniofacial Surgery department, identify those that need to be added to meet the requirements of this Agreement, and draw up an appropriate action plan for putting them in place in accordance with CFCFA personnel practices, procedures and standards.
3. Care of patients: CFCFA, in collaboration with the surgical team, will follow guidelines & protocols laid down jointly by Yenepoya University & Smile Train, in choosing patients for treatment, using methods of treatment & necessary documentation.
