
## TERMS OF REFERENCE

### CONTEXT:

**Snehalaya Charitable Trust, Tuminadu-Kunjathur post** (Name of NGO) is a registered/unregistered non-governmental organization involved in social service activities in Tuminadu-Kunjathur of Kasargod Taluk. It runs a residential care and support centre for the mentally ill, destitute and un cared in the society at Tuminadu ,near RTO Check post Kunjathur . For the benefit of patients welfare it seeks collaboration with YMCH for extension of health care & education services. Hence this MoU has been executed.

### ROLE and RESPONSIBILITIES OF YMCH

1. YMCH shall undertake a need assessment study for the purpose of initiating collaborative action.
2. Conduct free health check up camp for the inmates of the partner NGO at regular intervals.
3. YMCH shall issue Patient Referral Cards to the NGO for availing health services.
4. Referral cases will be given free treatment in the hospital upon production of duly filled in Patient Referral Cards. Such treatment cost will not cover cost of medicines, implants or any such other items as detailed in **Annexure**. However hospital shall provide antibiotics or medicines on free basis to patients whenever they get admitted under our specific need programme. YMCH shall provide medicines or any other services which are chargeable on credit basis upon request from the institution and the maximum duration of such credit will be for three weeks.
5. YMCH shall organize/conduct health care education programme in the NGO depending on the need.
6. YMCH shall offer incentives to the NGO to reciprocate the help/support extended to us as the case may be.
7. YMCH shall issue entry pass to the persons authorized by the NGO to visit their patients as per the rules of the hospital.
8. YMCH shall undertake this extension service through MSW Department and hereby authorize the HOD of MSW to liaison with the partner NGO for effective implementation, supervision and monitoring of collaborative efforts.
